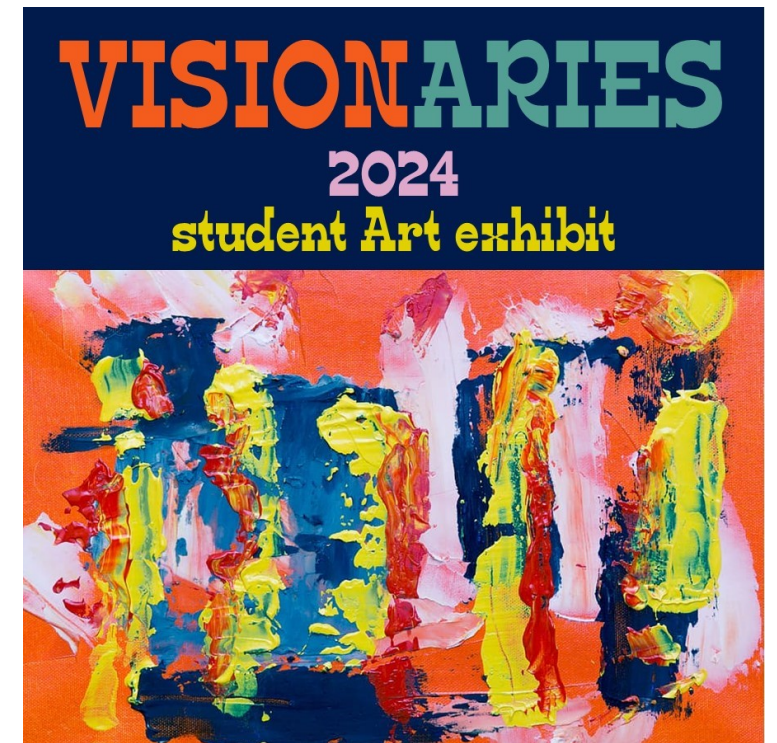

The exhibit is a great way for young artists to begin showing & selling their art professionally. The 38th Annual Visionaries student art exhibit will have a reception, FREE & open to everyone, on Sunday, April 6, 2024, from 2 - 4 p.m.

entry fees

\$4.00 per entry, each student may submit up to 2 entries.

Entry fees are due at time of artwork delivery. Make checks payable to: West Nebraska Arts Center or WNAC. Entry fees are non-refundable.

eligibility

The Visionaries student art exhibit is open to all student artists, 6th through 12th grade, within 125 miles of Scottsbluff/Gering. Art students of private instructors & home schooled students are also eligible. Artwork & completed entry forms must be delivered to West Nebraska Arts Center on or before the deadline.

All unsold artwork must be picked up after the closing of the exhibit April 29, 2024 or make other arrangements in advance.

We will not accept wet or unfinished work.. All pieces must be ready for hanging when they arrive.

sales

WNAC offers artists 65% commission for artwork sold with WNAC receiving 35%. Artist payouts for commission & award money are mailed on the 15th of each month or the next business day. Please be sure to list a current & correct mailing address on the entry form.

divisions

Please be sure your artwork is submitted in the correct division, as it will be judged within the division indicated by the artist. The number of awards given in each division is left to the judge’s discretion.

artwork requirements

Open to all original artwork (original artwork designed & created by the student.)

- Limit: 2 entries per artist.
 - Direct copies of published photographs, illustrations, or other artwork is prohibited & will not be accepted. **2-D work must meet framing requirements** & must not exceed 4’ (including frame) in any direction. 3-D work must fit through a standard doorway & weigh less than 75 lbs.
 - Unframed art on paper will not be accepted. Inexpensive “ready-made” frames are available in standard sizes at Hobby Lobby, Wal-Mart, Target, Walgreens, etc.
- Artwork that does not meet framing requirements will not be accepted.**
- All artwork must be identified with **two identification tags (front & back)** with the following information: artist, title, medium & price (or nfs).
 - Artwork must not have shown previously in our gallery. Artwork no older than 3 years old accepted.
 - All artwork in the VISIONARIES Student Art Exhibit must remain in the gallery throughout the exhibit (April 4 – 28, 2024).
 - Artwork must be picked up April 29th or make other arrangements. Any artwork left more than 60 days after the show ends will become property of WNAC.

framing requirements

WE WILL ACCEPT: wire back, centered saw tooth, centered hole.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT: NO way to hang, any double saw tooth or double hole, taped, glued, stapled wire or string. ABSOLUTELY NO EASEL BACKS WILL BE ACCEPTED!

Artwork that does not meet the requirements within this prospectus will not be accepted. Edges on unframed stretched canvas must be painted.

If label on artwork doesn’t match artwork the name on the entry form will be the title on display label.
