eligibility

The exhibit is open to all Western Nebraska Community College students and artists enrolled in the 2023/2024 school year. Artwork and completed entry forms must be delivered to West Nebraska Arts Center between April 23 - 28, 2024. After the exhibit ends all unsold artwork must be picked up after the closing of the exhibit June 30, 2024, or make other arrangements in advance.

artwork requirements

Open to all original artwork dealing with the theme. (Limit: two entries per artist.)

- 2-D work must meet framing requirements & must not exceed 4' (including frame) in any direction. 3-D work must fit through a standard doorway & weigh less than 75 lbs.
- Wire hangings are preferred. ٠
- All artwork must be identified with two identification tags (front & back) with the following information: artist, title, medium & price (or nfs). Make sure your tags match your entry form (if you do not label correctly we are not responsible for mistakes).
- Artwork must not have shown previously in our gallery. Ask if you ٠ are not sure.
- Artwork can be picked up July 1st. ٠
- Artwork must be dry and ready to hang

Any artwork left more than 60 days after the show ends will become property of WNAC.

framing requirements

WE WILL ACCEPT: wire back, centered saw tooth, centered hole.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT: NO way to hang, any double saw tooth or double hole, taped, glued, stapled wire or string. **ABSOLUTELY NO EASEL BACKS WILL BE ACCEPTED!**
